CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER & AWARD

AGREEMENT is made on the date last signed below, by and between the UPPER VALLEY ECONOMIC CORPORATION (UVEC), a legally incorporated 501 (C) (3) non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Maine and the Internal Revenue Service with its principal administrative offices at 36 School Street, Suite #4, Sherman, ME 04776.

UVEC and the Contractor, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement (the Contract), hereby agree as follows:

A. The Work.

The Contractor agrees to complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract including Extra Work in conformity with the Contract, **WIN 26578.00, for UVEC in the unorganized township T1 R9 WELS, County of Piscataquis, Maine**. The Work includes construction, maintenance during construction, warranty as provided in the Contract, and other incidental work. The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all supervision, labor, equipment, tools supplies, permanent materials and temporary materials required to perform the Work including construction quality control including inspection, testing and documentation, all required documentation at the conclusion of the project, warranting its work and performing all other work indicated in the Contract.

UVEC shall have the right to alter the nature and extent of the Work as provided in the Contract; payment to be made as provided in the same.

B. Time.

The Contractor agrees to complete all Work, except warranty work, on or before **May 31, 2024**. Further, the UVEC may deduct from money otherwise due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as Liquidated Damages in accordance with Sections 107.7 and 107.8 of the *Maine Department of Transportation Standard Specifications (March 2020 Edition)* and related Special Provisions.

C. Price.

The quantities given in the Schedule of Items of the Bid Package will be the basis for determining the original Contract amount and for determining the amounts of the required Performance Surety Bond and Payment Surety Bond. Accordingly, the amount of this offer is

SECTION 107

TIME

(Allowable Work Times)

107.3 Allowable Work Times. The Contractor shall request approval in writing from the Upper Valley Economic Corporation (UVEC) to carry on construction operations on Sundays or the following legal holidays: Indigenous People Day. The Contractor shall request such approval from the UVEC seven (7) working days before the date on which such work is planned to start.

Construction activities at the project shall not begin before 6:00 AM and may extend through the day until no later than 8:00 PM. Any work outside these times shall require written approval from UVEC.

Total weekly work time shall be limited to 40 hours per worker per week. The Contractor shall request approval in writing for work schedules requiring greater than 40 hours per worker per week. The Contractor shall request such approval from the UVEC seven (7) working days before the date on which such work is planned to start.
